### **Hearing & Vision Screening**

Monday 4/30 will be Hearing and Vision screening for all children 3-5 years old. This is mandatory by the IL Dept. of Health Services. There is no cost this year due to them receiving a grant. It does not count towards the Kindergarten requirements. If your child does not attend this day and you want to bring them in for the screening, please come between 9:00 & 10:30 and we will squeeze them in between classrooms.
